GOLF TIP: Chipping ----Bump it or Fly it. I have played with several of you who are great chippers. Inside of 20 yards, you are deadly. However, some of you have the same shot for all occasions. You mostly bump it up. It is frustrating if the only shot you have is a bump and run. What if you have to land it softly on a down hill green over a bunker? For this shot, you must fly it up in the air and let it land softly. The answer is not a 60 degree wedge. If you have one in your bag, you must be on the PGA Tour. For us, it is the easiest club to scull.

Learn to use your gap or sand wedge. The stroke is not a quick flip of the wrists like your bump shot. It should be slow and smooth. The stroke should be a sweeping motion more than a punch motion. Try to keep the flippy hands out of the shot. Let your arms sweep the ball. Place the ball a little back of middle in your stance until you get confident with this shot. Bring the club back like a normal shot, but as you come through the ball, try to sweep it. At contact, try to keep your hands frozen on the follow through. A slow smooth swing is the key. This will keep the face open and pop it up. Do not stop at the ball. Swing through it. Practice this a slot. Don't give up on it. Good luck.

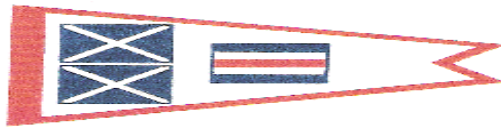
GOLF JOKE OF THE MONTH:
