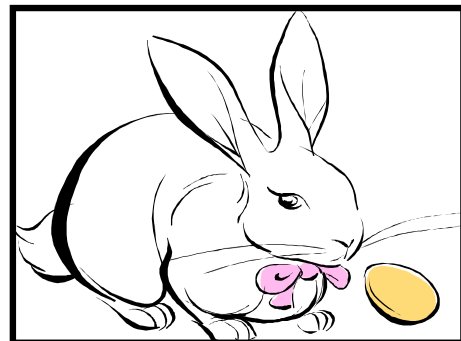
time and effort in selecting the candidates for the new Board. I would also like to extend my best wishes to the new candidates and wish them success in their new venture.

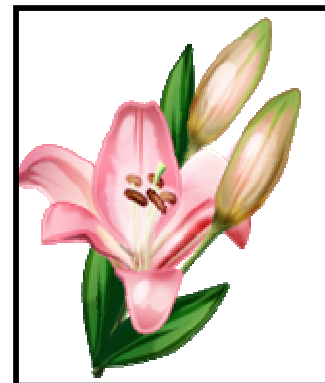

GOLF TIP: Grain and its effect on your ball.

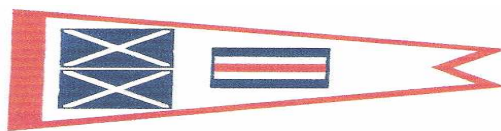
Some of you already know about the grain. The grain will grow according to the slope and/or the setting sun. The grain will make your ball break much more down hill than up hill. It is easy to tell which way the grain grows by looking at the cup. Just remember that water runs down a slope, so when the water reaches the hole, the grass grows on the side of the hole where the water enters the hole. So, the opposite side of the hole does not get much water, and the rim is either brown or bare from not getting enough water. So, if the brown side is on the left, the ball will break left. If the brown side is facing directly at you, you are putting "into the grain". "With the grain" is when the brown side is on the opposite side of the hole. If you see grain growing left and the slope is right, try putting it straight at the hole because one should counteract the other. You noticed I said "should"!
