Sam Miloro will chair the meetings in my absence. Thank you, guys!

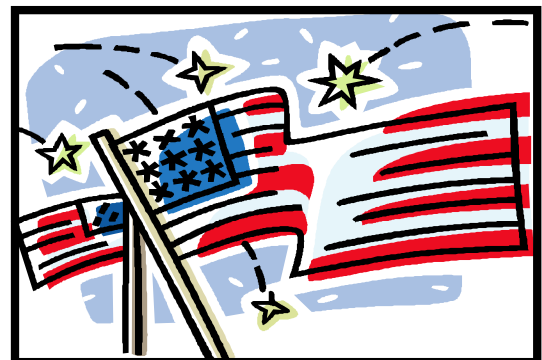

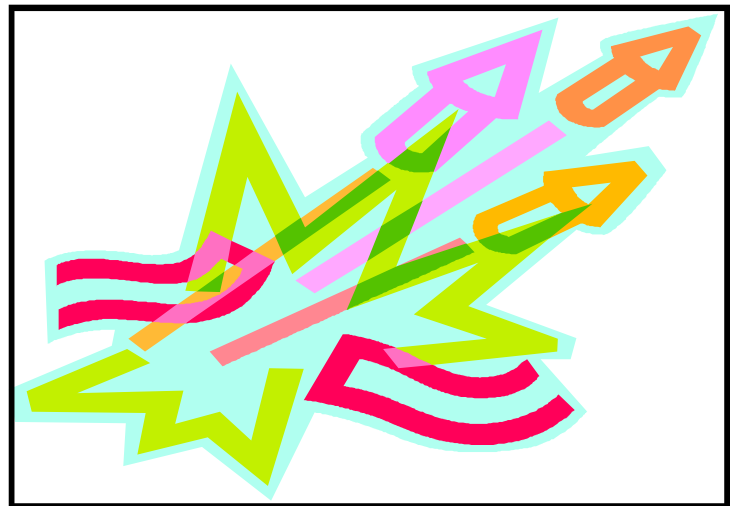

WATER HAZARD = The final resting place of all golf balls, that has a magnetized aura to it.

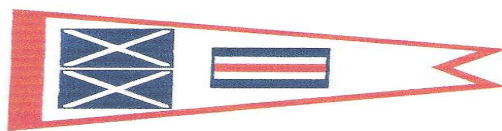
MULLIGAN = Invented by an Irishman who wanted to hit one more grounder.
