

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Since the State has had an economic shut down and social distancing has been in place, we have been forced to cancel all of our club activities. Restaurants are closed, so we cannot have our luncheons. All of the theaters have cancelled performances and therefore the entertainment opportunities we wish to attend are unavailable.

In March and April, the previous Board met by Video Conference. We were unable to meet at our usual site at Fifth Third Bank because the bank was closed to any inside activity. We will do the same in May.

As you may have heard, the United Church of Marco, where we usually have our monthly Club meetings, has closed its activities room to all outside groups for the remainder of 2020. The church is non-committal regarding 2021. As a result, we as a board are investigating other venues.

Planning for luncheons, dinners, theater opportunities, sporting events as well as many of our club activity and discussion groups will depend on the availability of various venues. Be extra eyes and ears for the club. Second, it will be helpful if you pay your dues promptly.


